Welcome to our wedding celebration! We thank you so much for joining us and trust you will have a wonderful time celebrating with us in our happiness! This event is about you as much as us, and Prague is as much a star of these days as we are, so we want to make sure you have an experience to remember.

Getting around

Prague has a wonderful public transport system. The main focus of our activity is Malostranské Náměstí (Náměstí means 'square') in the area of Malá Strana, which is on trams 12, 20, 22, and 23. The closest metro station is Malostranská (7 minute walk or 1 tram stop)

We recommend visitors purchase a 3 day travel pass if you plan to get around a bit. This costs 200 CZK and permits travel on all trams, buses, metro and funicular (& airport bus). Gordon has a pocketful of single-use tickets as well and can provide as needed. Please remember to validate your pass the first time you take any transport.

Trams and metros stop around midnight. If you want to travel by taxi, we recommend that you phone AAA Taxis on 14014 (+420 2 331 13311 from int'l) rather than pick up one from the street.

Schedule

Thursday 16.Sep.04

- 1730 **Girls night** party departs Strosmajerova Náměstí church.
1830 **Beer tour** departs from Dum u velké boty. Ends ??

Friday 17.Sep.04

- 1200 **Lunch and City Tour.** Depart from Malostranské Náměstí at 1200 via tram to Klášterní Pivovar at the Strahov monastery. Lunch at 1230 (280 CZK); depart for walking tour from monastery at 1400, about 3½ hours or as long as you hold out...
1900 **Family dinner.** Dinner is 1930 at Nebozítek Restaurant on Petřín Hill. You can either make your own way there or join us at 1900 at Malostranské Náměstí tram stop and we will make our way via tram and funicular. You can walk back (downhill!), or take funicular or call a taxi.

Saturday 18.Sep.04

- 1430 Gather for wedding ceremony at Ledebour Garden, Valdštejnské Náměstí 3
1500 **Wedding Ceremony** in the gardens.
1530 **Wedding Reception** in gardens.
1630 Official reception close, guests free to wander gardens (which close at 1800) Note if you leave the gardens you will need to purchase a ticket for re-entry.
1700 **Cocktail party** opens, Palffy Palac restaurant adjacent to Gardens, you may access via the gardens, or directly from the street Valdštejnská 12. All beer, wine and soft drinks are complementary (and pay attention to announcements of 'special' refreshments introduced from time to time!); any other drink may be purchased from the bar.
This time will be the best opportunity to present any gifts and personal greetings.
1830 Official toast and welcome
1900 **Wedding dinner** commences. Buffet style, no assigned seating – however we have marked 'rendezvous areas' where you are most likely to bump into people from various walks of our lives...
2000 **Celidh** starts. If you don't know what this is, you will soon!
c2230 The **Wedding Cake**, followed by DJ and more dancing
0000 Special event – stick around!
??? Dancing 'till dawn if you are up for it!

Sunday 19.Sep.04

- 1200 **Brunch** starts, Sovovy Mlyny, Kampa island, Prague 1 (Mala Strana). Cost of 500 CZK payable there. Also suggest a visit to the adjacent Kampa museum of modern art, or just a walk in the park... (Czech out those cows!)
1530 **Surprise event**, Lichtenstein Palace, Kampa Island (5 minute walk from Sovovy Mlyny). Finish about 1730.

Monday 20.Sep.04

- 1000 Excursion trip. For those remaining in Prague Monday, please join us for a day-long minibus excursion into Bohemia. Depart Malostranské Náměstí.
